Joining Instructions

What you need to bring

- 5 litres of drinking water
- Food, cup, plate etc
- Camping equipment suitable for the season
- Personal kit

• Cost

- £5 for a day visit
- £7.50 Day + overnight

When

- See Facebook announcements for dates
- Any time from Friday 16:00
- Leave on Sunday

How to get here

The nearest road access is on Binsted Lane, Arundel. **Note there are two entrances to Binsted Lane from the A27. The connection between them is not accessible by vehicle.**

From the Arundel/Ford roundabout

Take the A27 exit towards Fontwell

After the garden centre on the left the road becomes a dual carriage way

Binsted lane is on the left approx 1.5 km from the start of the dual carriageway. It is signposted to The Black Horse Pub.

Continue down Binsted Lane until you see a layby on the left with field access.

Park considerately. Large tractors pulling trailers use the road 24/7.

From the A29/A27 Roundabout

Take the A27 exit towards Arundel

Pass Mill Road on the left

Get into the right hand lane

Turn right into Yapton Lane

Turn very sharp left into Hedgers Hill after approx 500m

At the end of the road turn left

Continue down Binsted Lane until you see a layby on the right with field access.

Park considerately. Large tractors pulling trailers use the road 24/7.

From the parking to the camp

Note: you can no longer access the camp from the bridleway

With the layby and field opening on your left go down Binsted Lane until you get to the Public Bridleway on the left.

Follow the bridleway until there is an opening to the field on the right

Follow the field edge and turn right when you get to the trees

Follow the treeline until you reach the bridge.

Cross the bridge and there is an obvious path to the camp

It is approximately a 1.2km (10 min) walk from the parking to the camp.
